2. Recent events

- a. The Green Lane Run on 13th August was a full day's run, reaching the New Forest enjoyed by all and hopefully (please Keith) to be repeated next year. The gentle green lane run 22nd August saw 12 bikes (including international team Serow) cover around 50 miles of mainly gravel trails including the lovely West Woods, Strawberry Hill and back via Salisbury Plain.

- c. The last Castle Combe race circuit bike night is Weds 4th Sept. Entry will be free to VMCC members, same arrangement as previously strictly pre-booked entry only so if you haven't already done so, please let Jon Hall know by 31st August if you wish to attend so that your name can be added to the entry list.

Mid-week run Thursday 5th September Derek will lead a run departing the Fox & Hounds at Acton Turville at 10am, incorporating a café stop at the Old Prison near Northleach and returning to The Beaufort Arms at Hawkesbury Upton for lunch.
